

CANDIDATES FOR UNIVERSITY EXAMINATIONS MUST OBSERVE THE FOLLOWING INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY:

- 1) Candidates should take their seats in the examination hall at least five minutes before the commencement of the examination. Candidates presenting themselves half an hour after the commencement of the examination will not be admitted to the Examination Hall. Candidates should bring their **HALL TICKET AND IDENTITY CARD** each day for inspection by the Chief Superintendent / Invigilator.
- 2) Candidates are prohibited from writing any thing on their hall tickets or question papers.
- 3) No candidate will be allowed to leave the examination hall till an hour and a half after the commencement of the examination.
- 4) Candidates are prohibited to bring Cell Phones and any forbidden material such as handwritten / xeroxed / typewritten etc., matter into the Examination Hall. They should not communicate with any other examinee or copy his / her answers. Such candidates stand the risk of having all their answer papers of the examination rejected by the University and of being debarred from sitting for the University Examination.
- 5) Candidates must use only blue / black ink on the answer scripts.
- 6) Permission will not be given to the candidates to write the examination at a centre other than the centre where their names are registered.
- 7) In the case of nonreceipt of Hall Ticket, a **DUPLICATE HALL TICKET** will be issued by the Chief Superintendent in the Examination Centre on production of the Identity Card, one passport size photograph and payment of Rs.20/-.
- 8) Candidates are prohibited from writing the Name or Register Number on any part of the main / additional answer book except noting the Register Number in the space provided for on the cover page of the Main Answer Book.
- 9) Any identification marks including marking of religious signs and symbols on the main / additional answer script will be deemed as a case of malpractice.
